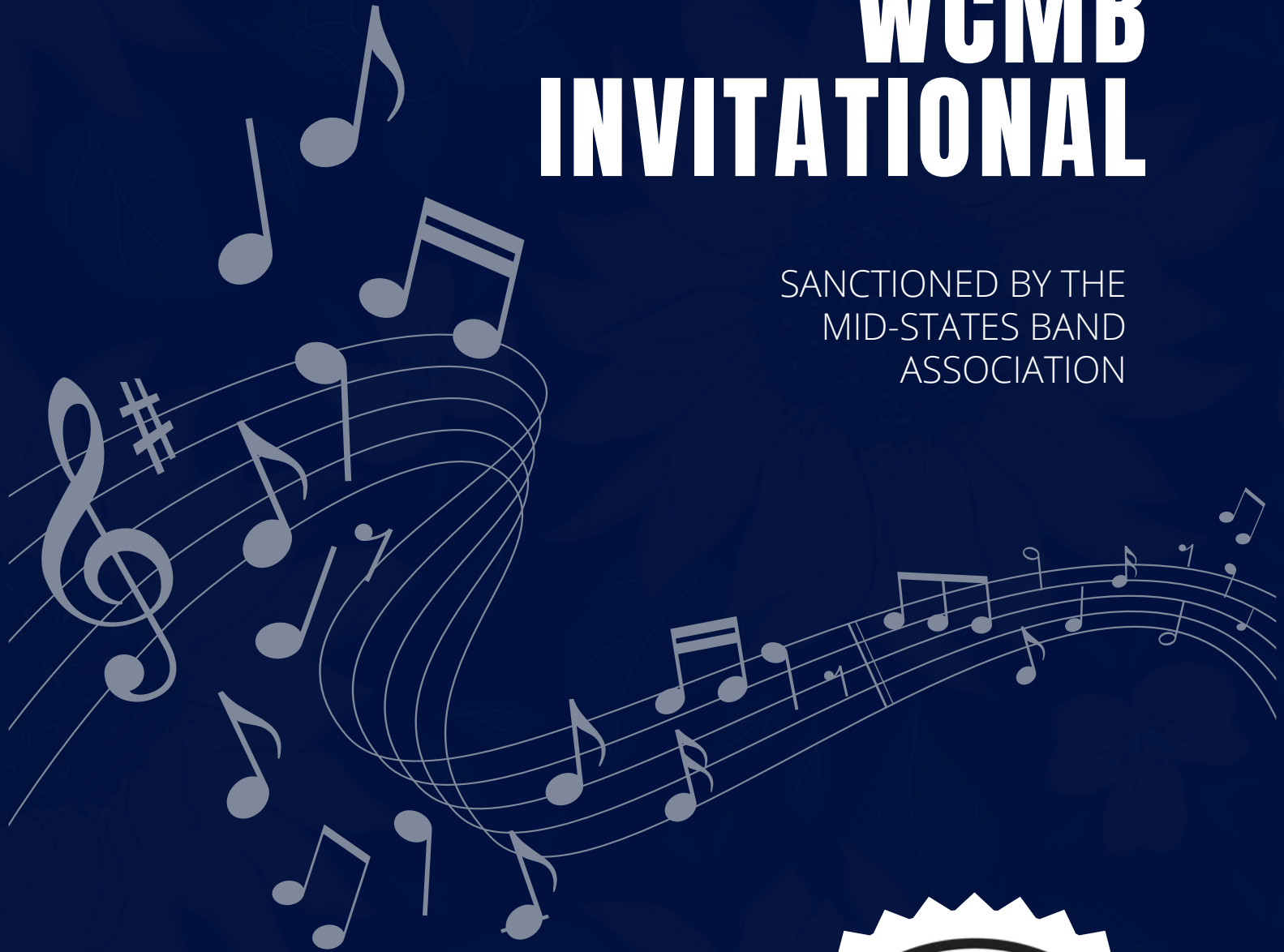

These total points will determine place finishers as well as the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion in each class. Awards will be presented as first, second, and third in each class: A, AA, AAA, AAAA, and AAAAA.*

INTRODUCING OUR JUDGES

Name: Josh Baker

Hometown: Centerville, Ohio

Josh Baker proudly serves as the Conductor and Music Director of the Springboro Wind Symphony from Springboro, Ohio. Under his direction, the Springboro Wind Symphony performed at the 2023 Ohio Music Educators Professional Development conference in Columbus, Ohio. Josh currently serves as a School Administrator for the Beavercreek City Schools. Prior to becoming a school administrator, Josh taught grades 5-12 band for the Greeneview Local Schools in Jamestown, Ohio, during the 2007 school year, and then served as the Assistant Band Director at Centerville High School in Centerville, Ohio, for 10 years. Ensembles under his direction have performed multiple times at the Ohio Music Educators Association convention and the prestigious Music for All National Concert Band Festival and Chamber Music Festival.

Also during his tenure at Centerville, Josh was the assistant director of the nationally acclaimed marching band known as "The Centerville Jazz Band," which competed on a national stage in the Bands of America regional and national championships. The band was a Bands of America National Finalist in 2008 and 2009 in Indianapolis, and it won numerous BOA Regional Championships. Josh remains an active professional member of OMEA, having served as the Co-Chair of the 2011 OMEA All-State Band and as the Chair of the OMEA District 12 High School Honor Bands several times during his tenure in Centerville.

Josh graduated with a bachelor's degree in music education from Wright State University in 2007. In 2015, Josh was named the outstanding alumni of Wright State University's School of Music and in 2017 was named the Centerville Education Foundation Outstanding Teacher and Hall of Fame Inductee. Josh earned a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership from the University of Dayton in 2013, and since that time has completed the requirements to be a K-12 Principal. He is a native of Cincinnati, Ohio, and currently resides in Centerville, Ohio with his wife and two daughters.

Name: Robert Fischer

Hometown: Germantown, Ohio

Robert Fischer currently serves as the Superintendent of Schools at National Trail Local in New Paris, Ohio. Prior to taking the position at National Trail, Mr. Fischer served as the Superintendent of Schools at Twin Valley Community Local in West Alexandria, Ohio; High School Principal at National Trail Local; 6th-12th Grade Principal in the New Miami Local School District in Hamilton, Ohio; and was the assistant principal at Chamberlain Middle School in Carlisle, Ohio. Before becoming an administrator in 2004, Mr. Fischer was the Director of Bands for 10 years in the Talawanda City School System; in the Brookville Local School System; and he also served as the middle school band director in the Preble Shawnee Local School System.

As a band director, Mr. Fischer's marching, concert, and jazz bands earned numerous superior ratings at both district and state Ohio Music Educators Association adjudicated events. Mr. Fischer's marching bands also performed with great success in the Mid States Band Association, including numerous top 10 placements. Mr. Fischer has served as a Marching Band and Concert Band adjudicator for the Ohio Music Education Association since 1999 and has been a member of the Central States Judges Association since the summer of 2006. Mr. Fischer has had the privilege of judging state championship events in Florida, Mississippi, Missouri, Ohio, Tennessee, and West Virginia.

Mr. Fischer's professional affiliations include the Lions Club International, Rotary International, Kiwanis International, Central States Judges Association, the Ohio Music Education Association, the Buckeye Association of School Administrators, the Ohio School Boards Association and the National Association of Secondary School Administrators. During his tenure as a band director, Mr. Fischer had the privilege of having such outstanding band directors as Bob Bass, George Edge, Greg Mills, Marshall Kimball, Jack Liles, Sam Reynolds, and Gary Speck work with his bands. Mr. Fischer currently resides in Germantown, Ohio with his wife of 28 years, Jen. Mr. Fischer has four children, Kyle (25), Michael (23), Elizabeth (20), and Madelyn (17).

Name: Jeff Waggoner

Hometown: Clarendon Hills, Illinois

Jeff Waggoner served as a high school band director for 34 years, retiring in 2011. For 26 years he taught at Hinsdale Central High School, in Hinsdale, Illinois, where over the years he served in various capacities, including Director of Bands, Music Department Chair, Coordinator of Teacher Technology, and Director of Jazz Studies. He holds degrees from the University of Toledo and Bowling Green State University, and he has done additional graduate work at Illinois State University, Vandercook College of Music, DePaul University, and the Keller Graduate School of Management.

Mr. Waggoner works as a freelance composer, arranger, and clinician. His recent book, *The Band Director's Guide to Marching Band Arranging*, is available on Amazon.com, and his music can be found at waggonermusic.com.

Over the past twenty-five years Mr. Waggoner has served as an adjudicator for concert bands, jazz ensembles, marching bands and drum corps. He has judged for the Central States Judges Association, Drum Corps Midwest, and Drum Corps International, working with ensembles in 18 states and Canada. He currently serves as the Assistant Director of CSJA. In 2021, Mr. Waggoner was elected to the CSJA Hall of Fame. Mr. Waggoner is married with two children and two grandchildren.

Name: Chuck Alfrey

Hometown: Middletown, Indiana

Chuck Alfrey is the Director of Music at Randolph Southern Jr./Sr. High School in Lynn, Indiana. He has been a music educator for 34 years in both Indiana and Florida. Mr. Alfrey's bands have consistently earned high marks at state festivals and he has guided marching bands to Championship appearances in both Indiana and Florida. He has also developed indoor guard, percussion and winds programs and has won numerous championships. Mr. Alfrey is also an active designer working with both marching bands and indoor winds groups.

Name: Stephen Alia
Hometown: Davenport, Florida

Stephen Alia is a professional visual designer for the marching arts. As the owner of Stephen Alia Visual Design, LLC, his active visual design clientele includes high school bands from Florida, Indiana, Michigan, New Jersey, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, and Texas. He is also the designer for three college bands, including the Rutgers University "Marching Scarlet Knights," as well as a member of the design and instructional staff for the Medellin Gran Banda from Medellin, Colombia, South America.

Stephen served as the Program Coordinator and Visual Designer for the Legends Drum and Bugle Corps, from Kalamazoo, Michigan from 2011 through 2013. Under his artistic direction, Legends was named a Drum Corps International Open Class Finalist each year and the 2012 DCI Open Class "Most Improved" corps.

Previously, he was a public school band director in central Florida for seventeen years and a member of the music education faculty of Southeastern University in Lakeland, Florida. Stephen was the Frostproof Middle-Senior High School Teacher of the Year in 2005 and has been listed in "Who's Who of American Teachers"; twice.

Stephen earned a Bachelor's Degree in Music Education from the University of Central Florida, where he studied trumpet with Lyman Brodie and John Almeida. He performed as a member of the Magic of Orlando Drum and Bugle Corps.

Stephen is an active judge for Drum Corps International. He adjudicates marching bands as a member of the Central States Judges Association, indoor guard, percussion, and winds with the Florida Federation Judges Association, and auxiliaries for the Florida Bandmasters' Association.

Name: Dr. Mark Cole

Hometown: Jacksonville, Florida

Dr. Mark Cole recently completed 11 years as Associate Professor of Music Education, Director of Bands, and Music Department Chair at Gardner-Webb University in Boiling Springs, NC. He holds the Bachelor of Music degree from the University of Central Florida, the Master of Music Degree in Wind Conducting from the Florida State University, and the Doctor of Philosophy in Music Education from the University of South Florida. Previously he spent 11 years teaching in the Florida public school system, directing bands and teaching at Ridgewood High School, New Port Richey, the Bands of America regional champion, 2002 Grand National semi-finalist, and 5-time FMBC champion Cypress Creek High School from Orlando, North Port High School, and the Douglas Anderson School of the Arts from Jacksonville, which won the 2006 Down Beat Magazine Student Music Award for the best arts school symphonic band in the nation. He was a music staff member with Arizona Sun in 1992 and on the design and instructional staff of the 1995 DCI finalist Magic of Orlando. Today, Dr. Cole performs in local big bands and small groups in his new location of Greenville, South Carolina.

During his career as a Navy musician, he served as Musical Director for the Midshipman Drum and Bugle Corps at the U.S. Naval Academy, Director of the Navy Band Memphis, Director of the Sixth Fleet Band in Naples, Italy, and served as the Assistant Director/Associate Conductor of the United States Navy Band in Washington, DC. His duties included conducting for four presidents, numerous senators and congressmen, and he was responsible for the day-to-day operation of the 172-person Presidential support unit.

Dr. Cole composes and arranges for high school bands around the country and is in frequent demand as a guest clinician, consultant, and conductor. He is a member of Phi Mu Alpha, Music Educators National Conference, the College Music Society, and the Central States Judges Association, and was selected for inclusion in the 2007 Who's Who in America.

Name: Del Duke

Hometown: Corydon, Indiana

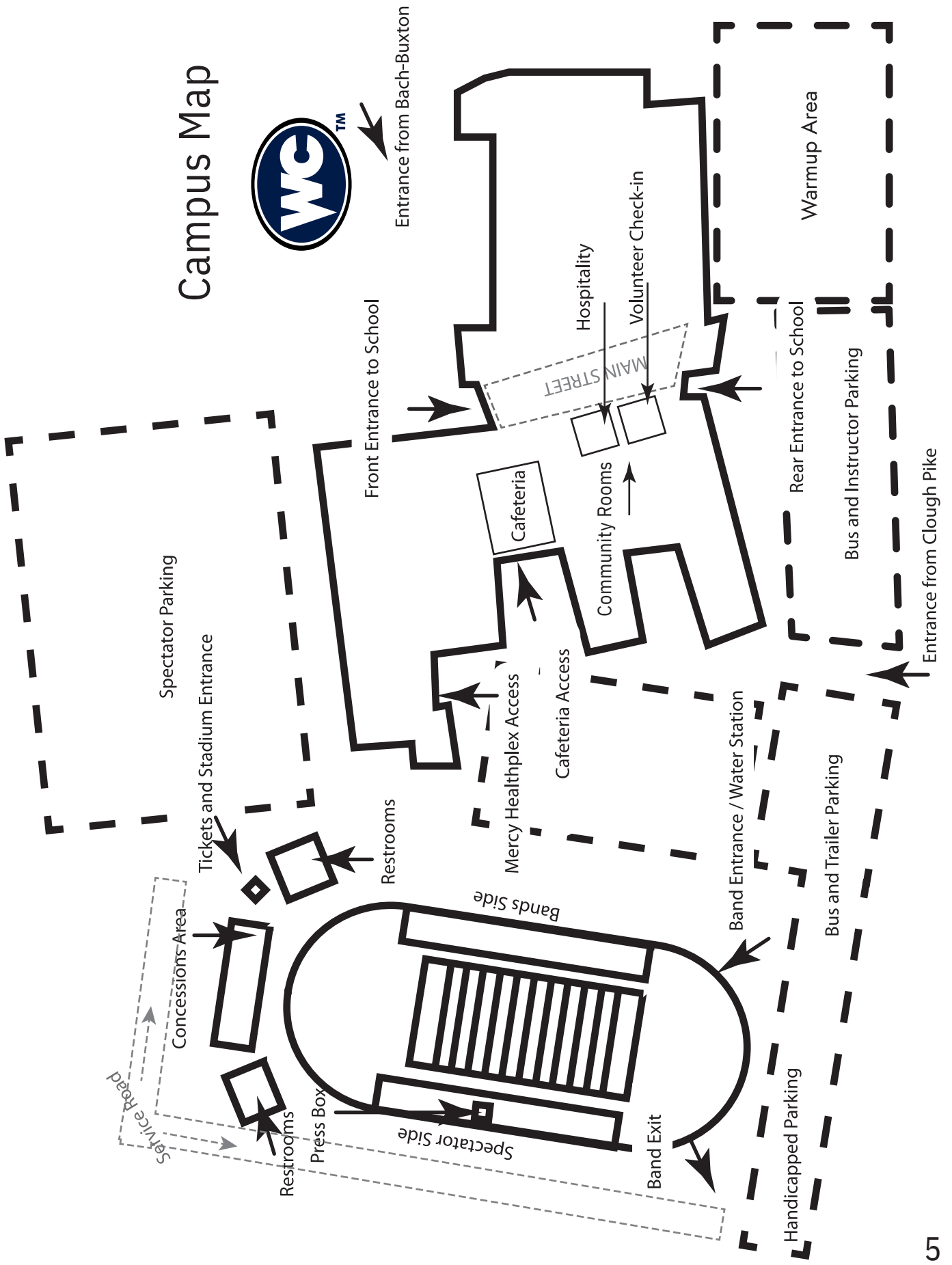
Del Duke holds a degree from Indiana University in Psychology. During the day, he puts that to use as an adult parole Officer for the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
