Home Football Games & Marching Band Competitions

When you volunteer for Feed the Band, Pit Crew, and Concessions during home football games, you receive free admission to the stadium. If you are not volunteering, you will want to be prepared to pay cash at the gate.

Admission to marching band competitions is typically \$15 per person. Please note that not all bands are equipped to take credit. Cash may be needed.
