The full band picture will be taken promptly at 4pm. They will then finish taking individual photographs. Plan to pick students up around 5:30pm.

Note: Seniors are welcome to use their senior banner photos as their individual pictures. They may also have their individual picture retaken at this time. In any case, they will be in the group picture.

9pm - Performance

The directors will have students send parents a text to let them know when the buses are about twenty minutes from WCHS. Students will be expected to unload equipment and there will often be a post-performance meeting on Main Street. Students will be instructed to send another text when it is time to be picked up from the school.
